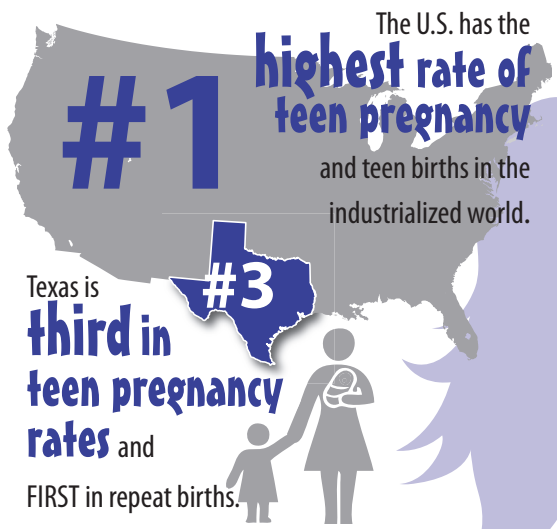




Alley's House empowers teen mothers to achieve independence



Alley's House exists to break the generational cycle and help teen mothers:

- ▶ Obtain their **GED**
- ▶ Receive **JOB TRAINING** and career preparation
- ▶ Participate in **LIFESKILLS** and parenting workshops
- ▶ Receive one-on-one **COUNSELING & MENTORING** through comprehensive case management

Teen birthrates are unacceptably high. About **4% of all teenage girls give birth each year** and teen births represent 10% of the 4 million births each year.

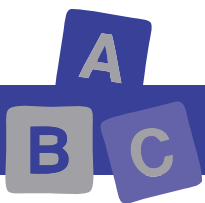
Daughters of teen mothers are 33% more likely to be **teen moms** and sons of teen moms are more likely to be **incarcerated**.



Children of teen mothers **struggle more in school** and are at greater odds for poverty.

Fewer than 40% of young teen mothers get a high school diploma compared with 90% of teen girls who do not give birth. Only 19% of teen mother's get a GED.

ONE MILLION DOLLARS Over the course of a lifetime, a high school dropout earns \$1 million less than a college graduate.
